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# WELCOME

Refinery hotel is the opulent reincarnation of the colony arcade building constructed in 1912 as a humming hat factory with an ornate, neo-gothic facade. The decorative early skyscraper model was designed by Frederick C. Zobol, a prolific New York architect. Zobol created an inspired variant of the 19<sup>th</sup> century “base-shaft-capital” design — in English, that means it had the proportions and aesthetics of a classical Greek column.

From day one, the colony arcade building became ground zero for the era’s rich millinery trade. Frederick C. and his brother Robert R. had chosen their location wisely: the neighborhood was exploding with business and visitors as couture houses and garment factories were setting up shop. It was the beginning of the garment district that we know today — Paris had become exorbitant and redundant for American designers and manufacturers.

Simultaneously, the shopping mecca of Ladies’ Mile, located from 14<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> streets since the turn of the century was moving upwards to Midtown.

It started with Lord & Taylor unveiling its glam window displays on 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Things at 63 W. 38<sup>th</sup> Street got really exciting when, less than a year after it’s unveiling, one local entrepreneur, Winifred T. McDonald, knocked on the Zobols’ door. Miss McDonald also had a vision: she signed a lease to the 20,000-foot space on the colony arcade’s ground floor and very soon was serving tea (wink, wink) to well-dressed women weary from days shopping and hot meals to the milliners on break from their hard work upstairs. These were the days of the “tea house”, when women were not welcome in the city’s clubs and bars but could establish camaraderie in the women-run salons and expect a “would you like gin or whiskey in that Russian tea?”. As the popularity of hats as a fashion staple waned and the economy of New York became more service-oriented, the building was re-purposed into an office building before its current incarnation as a boutique hotel. With a swanky lobby bar, a trendy restaurant, and a year-round rooftop, Refinery Hotel is a source of new life for New York City’s midtown and garment district neighborhoods.

The spirit of the dapper and hat-wearing Winifred T. McDonald lives on in both design and epicurean ethos. Refinery Hotel has carefully stripped, redefined and preserved the building’s culture and industrial innards. Gothic arched entries and windows surrounded by sculptural quatrefoils, shields and eagles still greet the hustling neighborhood and the hotel’s esteemed guests.

Materials from original water tanks and inner fixtures have been reworked into ceilings and furniture while interiors are detailed with tools of the millinery. Winnie’s lobby bar harnessed the energy, creativity, and sophistication of Miss McDonald by offering premium and artisanal spirits in a refined and elegant venue. Artistry and craftsmanship are on display in our bespoke cocktails, creative menu & live music combining to push boundaries, inspire experimentation, and transport you to a bygone era of glamour and refinement.

### **BOMBAY SAPPHIRE 13**

Beautifully aromatic, with a touch of juniper and ripe citrus with hints of spice.

### **BROOKLYN 12**

Quadruple-distilled and completely additive-free, it's diluted with water from belvedere's own artesian well.

## **KETEL ONE 12**

Dutch for 'pot still one', Ketel One is distilled from 100% wheat in copper pot stills, filtered over loose charcoal, and rested in tile-lined tanks.

## **STOLI ELIT 20**

A well-known soviet brand of vodka made from wheat and rye. Made with Latvian water and bottled in Latvia, but using alcohol from a distillery in Tambov, Russia. Distilled four times and filtered through quartz, sand, activated charcoal, and woven cloth. Freeze filtered at -18 degrees Celsius to freeze out impurities.

# RUM

## **RONZACAPA SISTEMA SOLERA 23**

Guatemalan rum with wonderfully intricate honeyed butterscotch, spiced oak and raisin fruit that showcases the complexity of the Sistema Solera aging process.

**PARCE 8 YEAR 12**  
Sweet & fruity on the nose.

## **BRUGAL XV 14**

A collection of rums aged 3 to 8 years in a combination of white American oak, ex-bourbon, and Pedro Ximenez sherry seasoned red European oak casks.

An aroma of prunes, dried fruit, toasted almond, and coffee with orange zest opens to a taste of espresso coffee, bitter chocolate, nutmeg, cinnamon spice, and tropical dried fruit and nuts.

## **GOSLING'S BLACK SEAL 12**

Bermuda's #1 export features a muted caramel nose with moderate alcoholic heat and sweet molasses.

Vanilla and spice follow and are consistent on the palate with added hints of liquorice and cinnamon, along with an herbal element. A true classic.



# TEQUILA

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## SILVER

### **AVIÓN • PATRÓN • DON JULIO 13**

Unaged and bottled immediately after distillation, or aged less than two months in stainless steel or neutral oak barrels.

### **ROCA PATRÓN 30**

Produced exclusively with the 'Tahona' process, distinctly different from classic patrón. A showcase of fresh and cooked agave to give a slightly earthy undertone.

## REPOSADO 19

### **AVIÓN • PATRÓN • ROCA PATRÓN • DON JULIO • HERRADURA**

Aged a minimum of two months, but less than a year in oak barrels.

## AÑEJO 20

### **AVIÓN • PATRÓN • ROCA PATRÓN • DON JULIO**

Aged a minimum of one year but less than three in small oak barrels.

## MEZCAL

### **ILLEGAL JOVEN 14**

Unaged mezcal with deep agave aromas, hits of green apple, citrus, and white pepper finishes with lingering heat and sweet agave.

### **ILLEGAL REPOSADO 22**

Aged 4 months in American oak barrels, caramelized pear and bitter orange show through on the nose, while clove, toffee, and hints of vanilla are predominant on the palate. Velvety throughout. An excellent sipping mescal.

### **ILLEGAL AÑEJO 41**

Aged 14 months in medium char French and American oak barrels.

The añejo is not blended for consistency, so each vintage is unique. The nose is light and smooth and opens with a camp fire smell that precedes notes of fruit and sweetness. The mouth feel is light with some smoke, finer fruits, and oak flavors, which finish with a pleasant tingle and a hint of charred oak.

### **DON JULIO 1942 58**

Aged in oak barrels for over a year, 1942 has a rich caramel and chocolate nose with a warm oak, vanilla, and roasted agave taste with a rich vanilla finish.

### **TANTEO JALEPEÑO 13**

100% Agave infused with fresh jalapeño. A uniquely delicious tequila with a savory heat.

### **GRAN PATRÓN PLATINUM 48**

For the true connoisseur of silver tequila, this may be the smoothest sipping tequila ever produced. Hand selected for their high sugar content, the agaves add a note of citrus and black pepper to the light oak finish.

### **GRAN PATRÓN BORDEOS AÑEJO 90**

Aged in matured barrels of a unique blend of American mountain oak and oaks from various regions of France, burdeos is aged for 12 months, then distilled once again and racked in hand-selected Bordeaux barrels. Complex aromas of oak, citrus, caramel and agave give way to a palate of dark berry, vanilla, and cocoa.

### **GRAN PATRÓN PIEDRA 110**

Crafted over three years using the 'Tahona' process, this añejo tequila is aged in new American and French oak barrels leading to aromas of fresh fruit and citrus, mushroom, and French oak. The taste is rich and sweet yet complex, its herbaceous agave flavor combining with light vanilla and mushroom, and leading to a long-lasting and remarkably smooth finish.

# BOURBON

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## **BULLEIT 13**

Fairly pungent and peppery with notes of marmalade and toasty oak on the nose, hints of smoke and banana cream.

Quite full to taste with notes of zesty orange, a hint of dried peel, a note of winter spice, cigar box, and perfume. Medium-length finish with plenty of spice.

## **WOODFORD RESERVE KENTUCKY 16**

The nose is thick and creamy with notes of honey and spice, leather, a touch of cocoa, smoke, oak, vanilla cream, and butterscotch. The palate is thick and full with notes of espresso beans, winter spice, cereal sweetness, rye, ground ginger, almond oil, toasty oak, and rum. The finish is long and mature with notes of cereals and toasty oaken spice. The house recommendation for your old fashioned.

## **BASIL HAYDEN'S 15**

The nose is crisp and fresh, spiced, rooty, and floral and big rye presence. The taste is gentle and rounded, with poised rye spice tingling through notes of winter berries. The finish is seed cake, vanilla cream, and more berries.

## **WIDOW JANE 24**

Named for the Widow Jane limestone mine in Rosendale, NY a source of limestone for the cement in many New York city icons (the Brooklyn bridge and the empire state building), the pure waters of the Widow Jane mine are used to distill Widow Jane whiskey in red hook, Brooklyn- a true New York City whiskey.

Aroma of butter, cream, and toffee reveals the taste of cherry wood and olive oil and a finish of burnt orange and spice.

## **HUDSON BABY 26**

From the first post-prohibition whiskey distillery in New York, the Hudson baby bourbon is mild and friendly, bright on the tongue and warming throughout with hints of vanilla and caramel.

## **HUDSON 4 GRAIN 26**

Hudson four grain bourbon whiskey brings together the distinct characteristics Of corn, rye, wheat and malted barley.

The grains are perfectly suited one to the others so that the end result balances the soft richness of corn, the sharp peppery notes of rye, all the smooth subtlety of wheat and the sweetness of malted barley.

## **HIRSCH SMALL BATCH RESERVE KENTUCKY STRAIGHT 18**

Classic bourbon nose of oak resin, vanilla, and soft fruits. The palate has an initial spiciness that leads to a complex mid palate of dried fruits. The finish is long and satisfying with a honeyed sweetness.

## **BLANTON'S 22**

The first official single barrel bourbon. It's matured in white oak, and each bottle is comes from an individual barrel with it's own taste profile. You'll just have to try this one for yourself.

# RYE

## TEMPLETON 16

Citrus and menthol aroma with light and fragrant hints of orange zest, cocoa, vanilla, allspice, and black pepper.

The palate is spicy with more black pepper, sweet with a bit of citrus, solidly herbal and has a minty backbone.

The finish is short but warming.

## BULLEIT 15

Big heaps of cherries and vanilla open the nose with subtle notes of leather and tobacco. The palate is rather hot at first, with spice on the front, followed by peach, more cherries, and orange zest. The finish is smoky, carried by cinnamon, allspice, and a hit of sweets.

## WIDOW JANE 18

The nose is of raisin and dried fruits, with a hint of spice from the rye. The taste has notes of vanilla and oak that give way to fresh honey, cinnamon, and spice within a velvety mouth feel. The finish starts with a kiss of honey that flows into the spicy rye and alcoholic heat.

## HUDSON MANHATTAN 19

The Manhattan Rye is fruity, floral, and smooth, with a recognizable rye edge that leaves no doubt of the spirit's origin.

## MICHTER'S US 18

'America's first whiskey'- founded in 1753, Michter's is made from select American rye grain that is sheared to allow more saturation during fermentation.

Aged in a heated warehouse, this rye has hints of light spice, black pepper, marmalade and plum, spicy grain, and light caramel.

## WHISTLE PIG 18

The nose is instantly expressive, with lots of buckwheat pancake sweetness, nutmeg, and brown sugar. There are hints of banana, toffee, black tea, pecans, mint, and honey. The palate is slightly dry, with a touch of grass and apricots. The finish is beautifully long, warm, and honeyed.

# JAPANESE

## YAMAZAKI 12 YEAR 19

The nose is of good body with plenty of nut oils and zest, a pleasant floral character with a little tropical fruit and a rooty note. The palate is smooth and soft with good sweetness and winter spice. A lovely citrus note develops with more tropical fruit notes and a little rum. The finish is medium with fruit and zest.

## HABIKI HARMONY 18

Blend of Japanese malt & grain whiskies from Yamazaki, Hakushu, & Chita. Notes of orange peel & white chocolate represent the Japanese seasons.

## SUNTORY TOKI 15

Light-bodied whiskey with notes of vanilla, apple & walnut. Finishes with slight heat and sweetness

# CANADIAN

## PIKE'S CREEK VINTAGE PORT BARREL 11

Aged for 10 years in ex-bourbon barrels, then given a final resting in port wine barrels to add color and complexity to the spirit. Begins with clear elements of sweet, ripe red fruit, laced with gingery hot pepper. Hints of menthol with a slight herbal edge slide into silky oak tannins. Ends with a cleansing citrus pith.

# AMERICAN WHISKEY .....

## **STRANAHAN'S COLORADO 18**

Strong hints of coffee, oak, oatmeal, vanilla, and caramel in the nose. The texture is full, and has a rich thickness that coats your mouth. There's a sweet coffee flavor and also a lot of vanilla and caramel, with a hint of a Scotch-like flavor from the variety of barley. The finish lingers and leaves a sweet vanilla and spice note.

## **CORSAIR QUINOA 16**

An intense nose of baked apples and a cinnamon/cassia undertone, the south American grain quinoa adds an earth and nutty flavor to the whiskey, which is moderately floral and perfumed with a mild scent of char. The palate is balanced and similar to the nose with a long, strong finish.

## **BERNHEIM ORIGINAL WHEAT 16**

Using winter wheat as its primary grain creates a soft, sweet flavor and medium finish to this small batch whiskey, aged a minimum of two years in new, charred oak barrels. The aroma is mildly sweet with hints of vanilla and honey, the taste hints at toffee, berries, and spice with fresh mint. The finish is soft toasted oak.

## **HUDSON SINGLE MALT 19**

Sweetish barley malt opens the nose with dried dark fruits, apricots, leather, citrus, char, and vanilla. The taste differs from the nose quite surprisingly - strong char opens with spiciness, papaya and citrus, and vanilla oak. The finish is quite long and slightly minty.

## **TIN CUP 13**

A bourbon in almost every sense of the word, tin cup has a delicious spicy aroma with strong notes of cinnamon, anise, and allspice. The first sip provides warm cinnamon and pepper flavors with bold rye, vanilla, and oak flavors. The finish is long with cinnamon, cloves, and anise that linger perfectly.

## **BALCONES 18**

Opening aromas bear hints of toffee and overripe fruits. On the palate, layers of toasted malt and honey give way to mellow notes of baked pears and apples.

# SINGLE MALT SCOTCH .....

## **BOWMORE**

### **12 YEAR 16**

Very floral nose with lots of peat and smoky heather with ash, hay, and zesty orange.

The palate is round with perfumed smoke, dark peat, and a blossoming oily sweetness. The finish is long and smoky with sea spray, dry grass, ash, and citrus.

### **18 YEAR 28**

Pungent nose with citrus, stewing fruit, hints of damp wood and a soft smoke. Palate is spirity at first, but gives way to perfume, fruit, plum jam- a good sweetness, grapey with peat smoke.

Finishes with hints of seville marmalade, blossom, and dark peat.

## **LAPHROAIG**

### **10 YEAR 17**

Sweet, spicy, and peaty. Epitomizes the classic islay character. Nose is pungent and smoky (coal smoke), with coal tar soap and iodine. The taste is surprisingly sweet to start, then salty and dry, with billows of tarry smoke and medicinal, seaweed-like flavours. Full-bodied.

### **18 YEAR 32**

Very big nose with a breakfast character (granary toast, salty butter, orange and coffee). Very rounded palate, and thick with golden syrup, salt spray, fiery wood spicy, dark and brooding peat, star anise, dark chocolate, and stewed prunes.

Finishes long with licorice, marmalade, butter, and kippers.

## **ARBEG 10 YEAR 16**

A ridge of vanilla leads to a mountain of peat capped with citrus fruits and a cloud of sea spray on the nose. Sweet vanilla with lemon and lime followed by surging smoke to taste with a long and glorious finish of sea salted caramel and beach bonfire smoke.

## **LAGAVULIN 16 YEAR 28**

Rich, sweet, peaty. The richest and most complex of islay malts nose of berries, sherry, sweet seaweed, camphor, and scented smoke. Big rich mouth feel, sweet with a blast of peat smoke with a long finish. Full-bodied.

## **DALMORE 15 YEAR 30**

A chocolate orange nose with potpourri, perfumed aromas of fruitcake and sherry. The palate is medium-bodied, with lovely delivery. Zesty orange, blue Curacao, chocolate, winter spice, and stem ginger. Hints of anise and a little hickory follow. The finish is malty barley and smoky espresso.

## **OBAN 14 YEAR 22**

Rich, smoky nose with medicinal notes and notes of the sea. Cut hay and wood smoke rise with a gentle estery sweetness. Thick, full-bodied palate with notes of citrus and smooth sweetness, wafting notes of seaweed. The oak is quite rich with grist, cereal, and malt. Good length on the finish of fruit and dry oak.

# SINGLE MALT SCOTCH.....

## **DALWHINNIE 20**

### **15 YEAR**

aromatic, toffee and fruit salad nose with lush nectarine and custard. floral with apple blossom, honeysuckle, apple peels and pear with a touch of oak. the palate is malty - walnuts steeped in manuka honey with vanilla sponge. gentle smoke weaves through the cereal with a touch of spice.

## **HIGHLAND PARK 32**

### **18 YEAR**

the nose is a profusion of ripe floral notes and fresh blossom with a delectable fruit salad. notes of honeyed exotic fruits with a little botrytis. the palate is creamy and full with fruit preserves and espresso. a creaminess with cinnamon and allspice. notes of toffee with thick black forest honey with a touch more citrus. the finish is long and well sugared with a herbal edge.

## **TALISKER 18**

### **10 YEAR**

the isle of skye's only distillery, founded in 1830. unique, peppery 'catch' in the swallow. no one knows where it comes from.

## **GLENROTHES SELECT RESERVE 15**

Lots of zesty rich fruit on the nose. Thick seville marmalade, bubbling on a hot stove with notes of toasted cereals.

The palate is silken smooth and utterly supple. Gentle barley whispers sweet nothings to the honey.

A little vanilla and malt with toasted cereal and sumptuous oak. The finish is long with mocchaccino and barley sweetness.

# SINGLE MALT SCOTCH .....

## MACALLAN

### **12 YEAR SHERRY OAK 18**

The nose is quite crisp and sweet. There are notes of sultanas and fresh apple blossom. There is a defined floral note with a beautiful sherry, calvados emerges with a tropical fruit note and golden syrup.

The palate is of medium-body and quite firm. There are notes of hot pastries and marmalade, sultanas and peels with a developing sweetness from the barley sugar. The finish is of good length with a solid oak note.

### **18 YEAR SHERRY OAK 30**

Classic spiced dried fruits and creamy vanilla with orange peel, crystallized ginger apple wood on the nose.

The palate is rum and raisin, dates, caramel and cloves alongside custard and citrus hints. Rich and satisfying and leading to a finish of spices and dried fruits along with warming ginger and a refined oak.

### **25 YEAR SHERRY OAK 99**

Very fruity nose with notes of orange and pear. Also has a good dollop of spices which develop into an almost smoky character.

The sherry in the nose is refined and well balanced, with hints of honey and caramel. The textbook malt delivery on the palate gives way to a mouthful of dried apricots, prunes, and figs.

Hints of nutmeg and cinnamon weave in and out of an epic whack of honey that only a Speyside distillery of this nobility can produce. The finish is long and full with fig, spices, chewy oak, and a touch of light smoke.

## GLENLIVET

### **12 YEAR 15**

Sweet, creamy vanilla, honey, pineapple, pressed apples, and a little cinnamon come through on the nose. The palate is of cored apples, fresh and fruity trifle, and creamy citrus. The finish, of almonds and apple, is long and delicious?

### **15 YEAR FRENCH OAK RESERVE 19**

The nose is rich and oaked. There are notes of chewy resinous wood with a well-balanced acidity. Fudge and madeira with apple crumble with calvados. The palate is full and rich with winter spice; cinnamon and cloves, thick oak with developing aridity. The finish is long and dry with a peppery note.

### **16 YEAR 29**

Rich aromas with hints of soft apple and fresh flowers on the nose - a little over-ripe grape and creamy vanilla. Spiced palate entry with apple/citrus core. Malted barley, alongside bourbon barrel notes of creamy vanilla and fragrant wood. Woody, spiced finish.

### **21 YEAR 58**

The nose is quite full and rich. There are notes of sandalwood and pine with a resinous note. Potpourri creeps in with barley sugar and cereal notes with acacia honey. The palate is rich and full. There are notes of oily walnuts and winter fruitcake with spice and sugar. There is a golden syrup note. The finish is long and sweet with a soft, chewy oak.

# SINGLE MALT SCOTCH .....

## BALVENIE

### **12 YEAR SINGLE BARREL 22**

Toasted, sweet nose with all kinds of charred oak and spice. Hints of maple syrup and allspice, a little vanilla and sweet coffee. A complex, thick palate with allspice and toffee apples.

Cooked fruit and baking spices, hints of sponge cake and creamy caramel prevail.

The finish is long with lingering sweetness and spice.

### **12 YEAR DOUBLEWOOD 18**

Supple nuttiness and some grape. The palate is sweet, with good body.

The bourbon characters develop; gentle spice with little vanilla, a balancing peat lurking quietly in the substrata.

The finish is dry and spicy, beautifully warming.

### **14 YEAR CARRIBBEAN CASK 20**

The aroma is rich with notes of tropical fruits- namely passion fruit – and a creamy toffee.

Sweet vanilla forms a creamy palate with notes of apples and mangos with a hint of orange in the background.

The finish lingers with a vanilla focused character.

### **17 YEAR DOUBLEWOOD 44**

Warm acacia honey and green apples on the nose leading to warm winter spices, vanilla and honeysuckle on the palate. The finish is gloriously long with notes of vanilla and honey.

### **21 YEAR PORTWOOD 44**

Elegant nose of white peach with a faint puff of smoke. Surprisingly delicate palate- abounding, yet fine.

Sublime mouth feel carries masterfully flavors of red fruit, raisins, an edge of white grape and very floral honey.

The finish is cocoa - slightly bitter as it tails away gracefully.



# BLEND S

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## JOHNNIE WALKER

### **BLACK LABEL 12 YEAR 13**

The nose is quite full. There are notes of winter spice and treacle, hints of white pepper and a little citrus.

The palate is quite rich and full. There are notes of wood smoke and dry spice, hints of barley and cereal with creamy toffee and a distinct herbal note.

The finish is quite fruity and long with a note of sultanas and mixed peels.

### **GREEN LABEL 15 YEAR 22**

The nose is quite rich and full. There are notes of mocchaccino and espresso coffee, wood smoke and a fireplace, a touch of bitter chocolate and oak.

The palate is of medium-body with notes of crisp cereals, coffee beans and chocolate, a date note with a touch of walnut. The finish is quite long and spicy with honeyed sweetness and oak.

### **GOLD LABEL RESERVE 36**

Nose of honey and heather with thick caramel notes and a subtle nutmeg spice. Dried meadow flowers and a hint of fresh banana. Smooth and succulent palate with a honeyed sweetness that's typical of Johnnie Walker. There's more to this though- the floral elements are quite prominent and there's a spiced sweet vanilla note, too.

### **PLATINUM LABEL 18 YEAR 38**

Sweet, rich, and deep notes of maraschino cherries, toffee caramel, vanilla, baked rhubarb crumble, and a very thin whiff of smoke on the nose. The richness continues into the palate, which is sweet and warming, with creamy malt, oats, and cereal. A spicy vanilla cinnamon dusting complements with gentle smoke.

### **BLUE LABEL 56**

The nose is fragrant, with good body. Notes of oak, crisp spice, dried fruit, and pastries. Berry fruits, aniseed, hints of cedar, a touch of spice, and citrus come through. The palate is supple and well balanced. The finish is floral, oaky.

## MONKEY SHOULDER 17

An elegant, stylish nose of marmalade, crema catalana, cocoa, and malt.

A sprinkling of winter spice (nutmeg, cloves, and cinnamon) adds an extra dimension alongside a mouth-watering hint of aniseed.

Very malty, creamy delivery which offers up a palate redolent of berry fruit, juicy, toasted barley, cloves, and butterscotch.

A hint of manuka honey, hot-buttered-toast, and dried apricot develop.

Medium-length finish, with clove-studded oranges, creamy vanilla, and peppermint on the tail.

## CHIVAS REGAL

### **12 YEAR 14**

Rich and generous with honey and hazelnut notes and a long, Creamy finish.

### **18 YEAR 24**

Balanced nose of orange peel, malted barley, vanilla fudge, and a touch of spice. The palate has a medium body with marmalade, and a touch of wood. The finish is long, well-balanced, with spice emanating from the oak.

### **25 YEAR 54**

Rich, nutty, and thick nose with notes of malt and berry fruits, hints of liquorice, raspberries and sweet porridge oats. The palate is soft and gentle, but it builds with an elegant, toffee-like character full of butter. Hints of boiled sweets, aniseed, and custard. The finish is earthy, with butterscotch on the tail.

### **21 YEAR ROYAL SALUT SAPPHIRE FLAGON 54**

Rich, malty nose with soft spice and cooked apples. A little manuka honey, apple blossom, salty butter, and marmalade. The palate is creamy and rich with barley malt, stewed fruit, and spice. Hints of soft smoke and acacia honey follow. The finish is long and fruit, the manuka honey reappears, and woody spice notes close.

# COMPASS BOX .....

## **ORANGERIE 15**

Flavored with Sri Lankan cloves, Indonesian cassia bark, and hand-zested navalino oranges. Sublime balance and a beautiful zesty flavour.

## **ASYLA 18**

Ethereal nose with melon, ripe, rosy apples, and delicate smoke. The palate is gristy malt, a touch of black pepper, grassy and oak with orchard fruit. The finish follows with fruity malts and oak.

## **OAK CROSS 18**

Light, stewed fruit, ginger, spice, and toffee apples on the nose. The palate is tart fruit and red apples, tannic and honey, with a tiny hint of christmas spice. The finish is oak, malt and milk, and a spicy sweetness.

## **PEAT MOSTER 20**

Peat, marked salinity, hints to Caol Ila in style, medicinal. Sweet and fruity, grainy nose. The palate is of oak, with botanicals, florals, sweet, smoky bacon, and a hint of papaya and copper. The finish leaves a lingering sweetness, more peat, sweet spice, oak, and more florals - roses and violets.

## **SPICE TREE 20**

The nose is fragrant and aromatic with notes of dried herbs, spices, oak, and vanilla. It has a bourbon note to it and a peppery tang. The palate is ginger nut biscuits, toffee spices, it's peppery, herbal, vanilla, and very rich. Spice tree finishes very spicy, big, and rich.

## **HEDONISM 24**

From that first, delectable introduction, hedonism is all ripe fruit, fraises des bois, and sponge cake with some interesting red pepper to finish the nose. The palate is sensual, disarmingly sleek and creamy. Black cherry and sweet spices follow, with some cereal notes. The finish is very warm and spiced, toasty, with some oak and milk chocolate.

# IRISH

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## **JAMESON 11**

The nose is full and floral with a smooth sweetness. Marmalade and fudge, madeira and a little cut grass note. The palate is thick and of good body with notes of orchard fruits, both fresh and cooked with a little vanilla cream. The finish is of medium-length with spice and honey.

## **BLACK BARREL 12**

Oily and fragrant with orchard fruits and vanilla on the nose. Full-bodied, with initial prune juice and a hint of sherry, with cocoa powder. Developing liquorice and charred oak in the finish.

## **12 YEAR SPECIAL RESERVE 15**

A robust, full-bodied flavor like a welcoming handshake. Complex flavors of toasted wood, spice, and sherry superbly mellowed.

## **GOLD 16**

The nose contains nice vanilla and oak aromas. The body is full, the palate offers notes of malt sugar, oatmeal cookies, and warm caramels paired against a pleasant tone of oak. The finish is quick and dry in classic Irish whiskey fashion.

## **18 YEAR LIMITED RESERVE 22**

Notes of grain, pot-stilled cereal, acorns, apple peels, and light spice. The palate starts with an explosion of ripe apples, gooseberries, and hints of pepper and spice. Nuttiness follows with underlying notes of cereal, apple & pear, and a touch of sour mash. The finish is long and balanced, introducing vanilla and oak.

## **MIDLETON VERY RARE 30**

The nose is complex and well-balanced with notes of spice, potpourri, wood resin, oak and juicy cereals. The palate is creamy and sweet with notes of fresh flowers, butterscotch and vanilla. The finish is long and spicy red breast.

## **RED BREAST**

### **12 YEAR 20**

The nose is nutty and rich. There are notes of dried peels and spice, an oily note and cut fruits. The palate is spice and of good body. There are notes of nuts and citrus and the peel and juice thereof. There are hints of marzipan and dried peels and a hint of sherry. The finish is long and creamy with custard and spice.

### **15 YEAR 24**

Fruity and tangy nose. Notes of zesty citrus, cut hay, guava, beeswax, Manuka honey, and tropical fruits. Palate is creamy and smooth with notes of cooked fruits, fried banana, orange groves, nutmeg, butterscotch and caramel lattes. Finish is custard, peppermint, and grapefruit.

# LIQUEURS

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## ANTICA FORMULA

A red vermouth variant by modern vermouth creator Antonio Benedetto Carpano. Richer and more complex than most red vermouths, request Antica Formula to elevate your Manhattan or Negroni.

## APEROL

An Italian aperitif consisting of, among others, bitter orange, gentian, rhubarb, and cinchona. Much like Campari, but milder and less bitter.

## B & B

Made from equal parts cognac and Benedictine.

## BAILEY'S

An Irish whiskey and cream-based liqueur, made by Gilbeys of Ireland.

## CAMPARI

An aperitif obtained from the infusion of herbs and fruit in alcohol and water. A bitter characterized by its dark red color, it's often used in cocktail and served with soda water, wine, or citrus juice. Invented in 1860 by Gaspare Campari in Novara, Italy.

## CHAMBORD

Modelled on a raspberry liqueur produced in the Loire Valley of France during the late 17th century that is said to have been introduced to Louis XIV during one of his visits to the Chateau de Chambord. Made from red and black raspberries, Madagascar vanilla, Moroccan citrus peel, honey, and cognac.

## COINTREAU

Orange-flavored liqueur produced in Saint-Barthelemy-d'Anjou, France, first set up in 1849 by Adolphe Cointreau, and first sold in 1875.

## MANDARINE NAPOLÉON

The original mandarin liqueur. This exquisite liqueur blends an all-natural mandarin distillate with rare spices and a 10-year-old aged cognac. While the liqueur celebrated its 125th anniversary in 2017, Mandarine Napoleon's roots date back even further to Napoléon Bonaparte himself; the man's affinity for Sicilian mandarins and cognac lead to the development of the recipe we still enjoy today.

## ITALICUS ROSOLIO DI BERGAMOTTO

Italicus resurrects the forgotten category of Rosolio, an Italian aperitif originally made popular by the King of Savoy and served to guests at royal soirees. Italicus has a fresh, floral and aromatic citrus complexity. The aperitif is made using the finest Italian ingredients, including bergamot, cedro lemon peels, chamomile, lavender, lemon balm, gentian and yellow roses.

# LIQUEURS

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## CRÈME DE CASSIS

A sweet, dark red liqueur made from black currants, used in the popular wine and sparkling wine cocktails, The kir and kir royale.

## CRÈME YVETTE

A proprietary liqueur made from Parma violet petals with blackberries, red raspberries, wild strawberries, Cassis, honey, orange peel, and vanilla.

## CYNAR

An Italian bitter liqueur that gets its name from the latin for artichoke, it also features 13 other herbs and plants.

A great negroni variant can be made by replacing Campari with Cynar.

Also great with soda and an orange slice.

## DISARONNO

A fruity amaretto with a characteristic bittersweet almond taste. It's 'originale' Amaretto's secret formula is purportedly unchanged since 1525.

## DOM BENEDECTINE

An herbal liqueur developed by Alexandre Le Grand in the 19th century and produced in France. Dom is an abbreviation for 'deo optimo maximo.'

## DRAMBUIE

A sweet, golden colored liqueur made from malt whiskey, honey, herbs, and spices. The name derives from the Scottish Gaelic phrase an dram buidheach, 'the drink that satisfies.'

## GODIVA

A chocolate liqueur based on godiva chocolate.

## LUXARDO MARASCHINO

A liqueur from the city of Zadar in Dalmatia, Croatia, obtained from the distillation of marasca cherries.

## KAHLUA

A Mexican coffee-flavored, rum-based liqueur that also contains, sugar, corn syrup, and vanilla bean.

## FRANGELICO

A brand of hoisette and herb-flavored liqueur produced in Canale, Italy. The name is based on the legend of a hermit named Fra Angelico who 'created unique recipes for liqueurs.'

## GRAND MARNIER

An orange-flavored cognac liqueur created in 1880 by Alexandre Marnier-Lapostolle. It's made from a blend of cognac brandy, distilled essence of bitter orange, and sugar.

## GREENHOOK GINSMITHS BEACH PLUM

Inspired by traditional English sloe gins, the first ever commercially released beach plum liqueur in the world is the result of the marriage between greenhook's signature dry gin, local beach plums, and organic turbinado sugar.

## DOMAINE DE CANTON

A ginger-flavored liqueur produced in Jarnac, France which contains syrup made from crystallized Chinese baby ginger, Champagne, V.S.O.P cognac, orange blossom honey from Provence, and vanilla.

## LILLET BLANC

A French aperitif wine which is a blend of 85% Bordeaux wines and 15% macerated liqueurs, mostly citrus, from the peels of sweet oranges from Spain and Morocco and bitter green oranges from Haiti.

## NOILLY PRAT DRY VERMOUTH

Aromatized fortified wine flavored with various botanicals, it's one of the most versatile cocktail ingredients.

## FERNET BRANCA

Invented in milan in 1845 by Maria Scala, it features the bitter tone of Colombo and aloe with the unmistakable character of gentian. Bitter aftertaste prevails over the spicy tones of myrrh. A classic to round out the evening.

# LIQUEURS .....

## PERNOD ANISE

Anise-flavored liqueur from a French company first founded in 1797.

## PIMM'S NO.1 CUP

A gin based liqueur that contains a secret recipe of herbs. Excellent with citrus fruits, champagne, or 7-up.

## PUNTE MES

Italian vermouth- 'point and a half' in Piedmontese who's flavor is characterized anecdotally as 'one point of sweetness and a half a point of bitterness', Punt e Mes is a great substitute for red vermouth in a Manhattan or a Martinez for those who like their cocktails a bit more bitter.

## RAMAZZOTTI

A medium style Amaro (Italian potable bitters) bottled in Milan.

## SAMBUCA

Italian anise-flavored liqueur. Flavored from essential oils obtained from anise, star anise, liquorice, elderflower, and other spices.

## THATCHER'S ELDERFLOWER

Delicate flavors of Elderflower yield to the alluring floral hint of a fresh spring dew. Excellent with vodka, champagne, or white wine.

## THATCHER'S PRICKLY PEAR

Sweet, tart, and luscious, Prickly Pear is a great addition to margaritas, martinis and lemonades.

# AFTER DINNER .....

## **BLACK DIRT APPLE JACK 12**

The quintessential American spirit imbued with history, controversy, and fruit. 100% Apple Brandy aged a minimum of 4 years in new charred American Oak Barrels.

## **CARDENAL MENDOZA 18**

The nose is round and clean- elegant. Reminders of wine, distinguished with hints of raisins and plums. The palate is full of molasses and wood.

## **COGNAC D'USSE VSOP 18**

The nose is clean, with aged aromas of raisins, figs, citrus peel, orange blossom, cedar, caramel, ginger, nutmeg, and cardamom. The palate is dry and smooth, warming alcohol with a hint of controlled fire, and medium body.

## **HENESSEY VS 16**

Very bold. Opens with sweet wood and nutty fragrances. The palate is warm and filled with floral notes and wood. Overpowering but boldly pleasing.

## **LARRASINGLE VSOP 19**

Pleasant aroma of raisins, brown sugar, and the slightest hint of dark leather. A bolder, more robust spirit than its cousin Cognac.

## **MARTEL VSOP 18**

The nose is gentle, subtly fruity, with vanilla, dry spices, and oak. The palate is fruity and dry with honey and spices. The finish is long, with sweet fruit.

## **REMY MARTIN LOUIS XIII 275**

A century in a glass.

## **REMY MARTIN VSOP 18**

The nose is sweet with honey and vanilla, floral notes and chewy oak, lots of blossom and spice. The palate is spiced and rich, fruity notes of nectarine and dried apricot and plum, floral and oaked. The finish has tart fruits and honey.

## **REMY XO 54**

The nose is fruity with dates and peels, honey and a little marmalade, Overripe grape and warm pastries. The palate is spicy with warm pastries.

## **HENNESSY VSOP 20**

This cognac is slowly matured in wood barrels. The flavors are fresh and light with notes of honey and spice.

## **HENNESSY XO 54**

This cognac possesses sense of crystallized fruit, oak, spices and lather. After tastes of cinnamon & vanilla.
